Our entrance fee, which has been at £2 now for 12 years & is our only source of income as we don't have membership fees, would not cover our costs if we did not have some "home-grown" productions. We celebrated 100 years of the Village Hall Trustees last May & in September Kevin Knights told us about the archaeological dig at Hoxne in 1978. In January we had an emotional evening when Alistair showed his video of interviews with Charmion Pearmain.

We've also had a varied selection of outside speakers. We also had two talks with links to WWII: Mike Levy told the moving story of the Jewish kindertransport children who stayed at the Dovercourt holiday camp & Geoffrey Kay talked about the American Airforce in East Anglia.

We had 2 summer visits: a small group had a fascinating evening viewing Mike Baker's collection of large stationary engines at Surwood Farm & in August we spent an afternoon finding out about Christchurch Mansion in Ipswich.
