The Village Care Group exists to ensure every resident in the village has someone to turn to in case of problems or queries. We deliver 'Welcome' leaflets and footpath maps to new residents, giving them contact details of the Care Group member overseeing their part of the village. We are able to direct enquirers to appropriate services and organisations for all kinds of information and support. We organise the Food Bank boxes located in Village Hall and church, taking produce to the distribution centre in Stowmarket. We also run a taxi service for those without transport needing to collect prescriptions or attend appointments at hospitals or health centres. For this there is no set charge, but donations are welcome and enable us to reimburse our drivers' fuel costs.

Due to continual turnover of Care Group committee personnel as members retire for various reasons, we are always pleased to welcome newcomers either on to our committee or as volunteer drivers.
